Photoshop Tip of the Month

- **Tricks to use when selecting an object -**
 - while you're creating the selection – press and hold the SPACE bar to move it around
 - after selecting say a circle, if you want to resize it, use SELECT → TRANSFORM SELECTION (you can't just use the FREE TRANSFORM function, as it will transform the entire canvas)
 - holding the CTRL key will allow you to change just a single side of the selection
 - holding the SHIFT key will allow you to ADD to the selection, and holding the ALT key will allow you to SUBTRACT from the selection.
